## In-House Financing

TOSI University offers in-house financing options, complemented by short-term external financing partnerships with esteemed corporate entities. To initiate in-house financing, students contribute a minimum deposit of \$2000 to the TOSI University Finance Department, establishing a *non-credit check payment plan*. While additional payments exceeding \$2000 are accepted to decrease the in-house financed amount, the minimum deposit to commence the plan is \$2000.

## **Deposit Financial Constraints**

For those unable to afford this initial deposit, a hybrid solution combining in-house financing with external financing options is available, including partners such as:

- Klarna
- Cherry
- AfterPay
- Sezzle
- Future Pay

The remaining balance is then internally financed through TOSI Finance, incurring an 11% interest rate. Payments commence two months after enrollment, and the student may start making payments before the semester begins.

## **Next Steps**

Depending on the enrolled educational programs, a personalized monthly payment plan estimate is provided, valid for 30 days. Upon acceptance, students finalize their enrollment by making the deposit, signing financing contracts, and receiving comprehensive details such as monthly payment dates, amounts through a TOSI Finance deliverables table, and links to facilitate their monthly payments.

This in-house financing option seamlessly integrates with other TOSI Financial Aid alternatives, encompassing scholarships, grants, internships, external financing, and self-pay options.

## **Outside Financing**
